

On Friday evening, May 22, on PBS at 9 p.m. EDT, Bill Moyers Journal (<http://www.pbs.org/moyers/journal/05222009/watch.html>) will feature a discussion with Dr. David Himmelstein, co-founder of PNHP, and other single-payer advocates. They will respond to the question, "Why isn't a single-payer plan on the table in Washington?" This important discussion on the Moyers show is part of a recent surge in media interest in the single-payer alternative. This interest has followed the bold and courageous acts of civil disobedience undertaken by the **Baucus 13, PNHP members and others, before meetings of the health care subcommittee of the US Senate Finance Committee, chaired by Senator Max Baucus (D. Montana) earlier this month. Having repeatedly been refused the chance to testify before the subcommittee, the **Baucus 13** resorted to non-violent protest by speaking out of order during the subcommittee's hearings and then submitting themselves peacefully to immediate arrest.**
